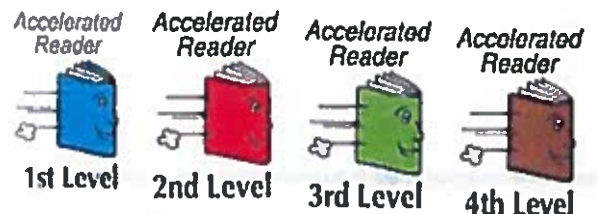

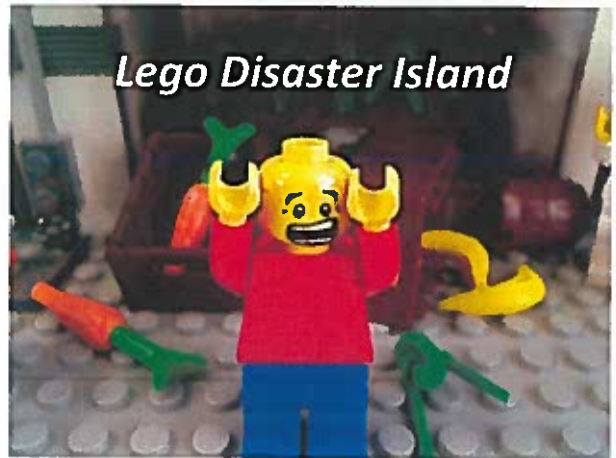

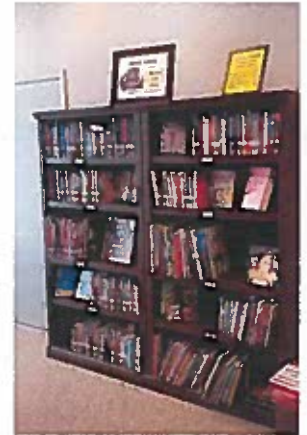

Come to our meeting and learn from Laura, how you can help individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities to become accepted in our schools and community and how to advocate for them.

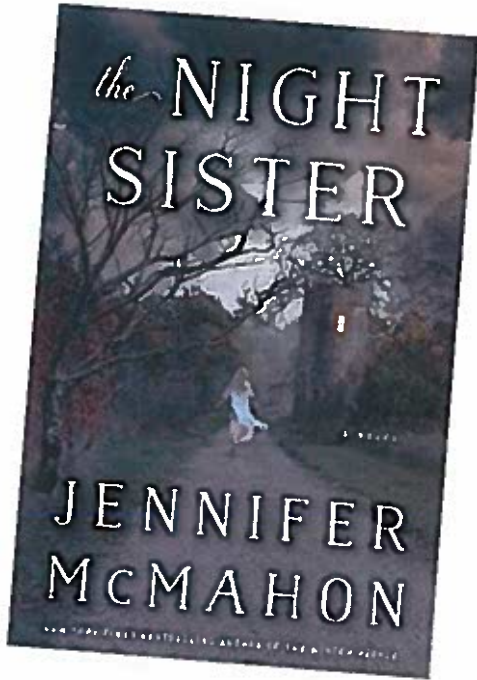

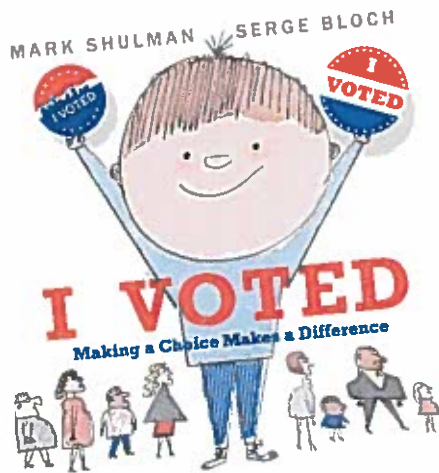
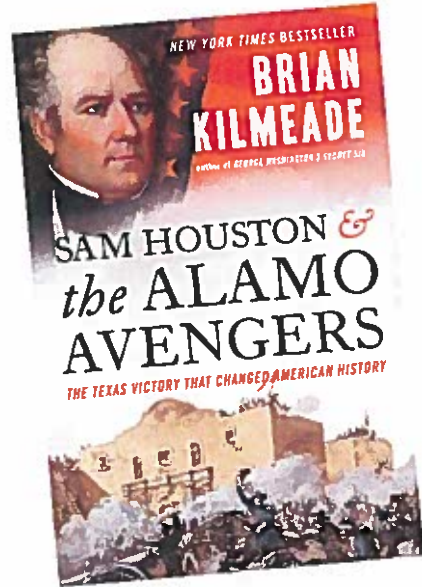

Copies/Printing.....15¢ page

Fax.....\$1.00 for first page, 50¢ per additional page

Meeting Room (offered upon availability)

Nonprofits.....\$25/year

Out of Area Patrons (surrounding area)

\$10 individual, \$15 couple, \$25 family
