1. Extension Of The State Of Disaster As Declared By The County Judge On October 16, 2018.

Approved Order Authorizing Extension Of Local State Of Disaster For Period From October 20, 2018 Until December 11, 2018.

2. Discussion And Planning Of Initial Assessment For Application To FEMA For Disaster Relief And Reimbursement Of Expenditures.

Authorized Overtime Pay To Llano County Employees As Needed Under The Direction Of The EOC During Disaster/Emergency Situations.

3. Discussion And Planning For Procurement Of Services For Debris Removal And Boat Removal/Storage.

**MOTION:** Moss; Second Sandoval: **UNANIMOUS. MOTION PASSED.**  
Proceed With RFPs Or RFQs For Debris Removal In Compliance With Federal Guidelines.
