BRUSH DUMPING

Brush dumping is now open to everyone. All customers must come by the main office to pay and receive their receipt before they can proceed to dump their brush. ([Map to Brush / Mulch Site](#))

Hours of Operation:

Monday through Friday (excluding Holidays) 8:00 AM – 12:00 noon

The fee is: \$2.50 per cubic yard up to 50 cubic yards and \$5.00 per cubic yard over 50 cubic yards.

RV DUMPING

Hours of Operation: Monday through Friday (excluding Holidays) 8:00 AM – 3:30 PM

The fee is \$5.00 per 200 gallon maximum dump. This includes 100 gallons of potable water.

OIL AND OIL WITH WATER

Hours of Operation: Monday through Friday (excluding Holidays) 8:00 AM – 3:30 PM

Free to drop off includes the following: Oil without water, antifreeze, cooking oil, gasoline, diesel, and hydraulic fluid.

\$0.50 each per oil filter disposal fee.

\$1.50 per Gallon for Oil **WITH** water disposal

TIRE DISPOSAL FEES (WITHOUT RIMS) ([Map to Tire Disposal](#))

Hours of Operation: Monday through Friday (excluding Holidays) 8:00 AM – 3:00 PM

\$1.75 per tire for the following: Smaller than fourteen (14”) inch tire and motorcycle, bicycle, golf cart, lawn mower, ATV, etc.

\$2.50 per tire for the following: Fourteen (14”) inch tire through twenty-four (24”) inch tire

Tires larger than twenty-four (24”) inches will not be accepted.

SEPTIC TANK TREATMENT FACILITY FEES

Septic Hauler Annual Permit Application Fee - \$50.00

Septic waste usage fees (based on maximum tank volume of vehicle dumping) - \$8.25 per 100 gallons. Surcharge for loads with grease sample test results over 200 mg/L – 3 times the usage rate.
