### **FEES:**

- o GENERAL: \$2.50 per cubic yard up to 50 cubic yards and \$5.00 per cubic yard over 50 cubic yards.
- o RV DUMPING: \$5.00 per 200 gallon maximum dump. This includes 100 gallons of potable water.
- o OIL AND OIL WITH WATER (antifreeze, cooking oil, gasoline, diesel, and hydraulic fluid):
  - \$0.50 each per oil filter disposal fee.
  - \$1.50 per Gallon for Oil WITH water disposal
- o TIRES:
  - \$1.75 per tire for the following: Smaller than fourteen (14") inch tire and motorcycle, bicycle, golf cart, lawn mower, ATV, etc.
  - 2.50 per tire for the following: Fourteen (14") inch tire through twenty-four (24") inch tire
  - Tires larger than twenty-four (24") inches will not be accepted.
