Llano County Elections Office is excited to announce the first-ever “I Voted” & “Future Voter” sticker design contest! We invite Llano County students grades K-5 to create a “Future Voter” design, and those Grades 6-8 and 9-12 can submit an “I Voted” design. Whether you’re enrolled in public, private, or homeschool, your artwork has a chance to shine. The three winning designs will become the official stickers used in upcoming elections, and each voter will receive theirs after voting during early voting and Election Day.

These special stickers will feature unique Llano County designs, celebrating our community’s creativity and encouraging more people to get involved in elections. We’re excited to see the wonderful talent and imagination of our future voters!

After all submissions are in, a friendly panel of judges will select the top three designs. They’ll look at creativity, originality, artistic style, and how well they capture the spirit of Llano County.

Winners will hear from the Elections Office by July 1, 2026. The winning designs will be showcased at the Llano National Bank, Arrowhead Bank and Cadence Bank as well as, on our website, in the Local Newspaper and first handed to voters on November 3, 2026 (Election Day).

All entries must be received by May 2, 2026 (Local Election Day), at 5:00 PM. 1. HOST

Llano County Elections Department

2. SPONSOR

This contest is sponsored by Llano National Bank, Arrowhead Bank and Cadence Bank

3. CATEGORIES

There are 3 categories as follows:

- Grades K-5- “FUTURE VOTER”
- Grades 6-8- “I Voted”
- Grades 9-12- “I Voted”

4. EILIGIBILITY

- Currently enrolled in public, private or homeschool in Llano County, Texas.
- Immediate family members of the Sponsor of contest judges or members of their household are not eligible to participate

5. HOW TO ENTER

Designs may be submitted beginning on March 3, 2026 (Primary Election Day). To enter, you must submit your artwork entry form and consent form electronically to vr@co.llano.tx.us or in person to our office at 1447 East State Hwy 71, Llano, TX 78643. All required forms and artwork must be received by 5:00 p.m. on May 2, 2026 (Local Election Day). Late entries will not be accepted. A limit of two entries will be permitted per participant, and no entry fee is required to participate in this contest. Should any questions arise, please email vr@co.llano.tx.us. Judging will completed by July 1, 2026.

6. Design Requirements – “I Voted” Sticker- Grades 6-8 and Grades 9-12

The design must include the phrase “I Voted” and contain the theme of voting and elections in the state of Texas or Llano County. Designs may not include a date. Artists are encouraged to but not required to include Llano County's landmarks, history and local flavors in their designs. Designs should be nonpartisan in nature.

7. Design Requirements - “Future Voter” Sticker- Grades K-5

The design must include the phrase “Future Voter” and contain the theme of voting and elections in the state of Texas or Llano County. Designs may not include a date. Artists are encouraged, but not required to include Llano County's landmarks, history, and local flavors in their designs. Designs should be nonpartisan in nature.

8. FILE FORMAT

The dimensions of the design should fit on a circular sticker two inches in diameter; the attached template can be used. The colors should be flat, and the design should implement block shading when applicable with no gradient/transparent color schemes. To accommodate print quality, digital designs should be submitted as an email attachment to vr@co.llano.tx.us. Be sure to include any fonts, support files (such as scans or logos).

The files are accepted in the following formats:

- Adobe Illustrator (AI, PDF, EPS, AIT, SVG, SVGC)
- Adobe Photoshop (PNG, JPEG, TIFF)
- Adobe InDesign (INDD, PDF)

If you are submitting an EPS, TIFF, JPEG, BMP, or PNG files they must be a minimum of 600 pixels per inch for line art and type, or 300 pixel per inch for photographic images. PDF files are accepted, but we prefer the original files. Please be sure your PDF file is high-resolution quality art.

Please use spot color designs in Photoshop Spot Color channels (not layers) or use a vector illustration program like FreeHand or Illustrator. Files with transparency effects, please ensure that your document's raster effects settings are set to 300 pixel per inch output to ensure the best possible reproduction.

IMPORTANT: Microsoft Word, Publisher, PowerPoint documents, CorelDraw documents, low-resolution web images, WordPerfect documents or CAD drawings as artwork are not accepted.




