**COVID-19 (New Coronavirus)** 

Llano, TX- At 10:00 AM today, the Llano County Local Health Authority (LHA), Dr. Jack Franklin notified Llano County Judge, Ron Cunningham and Horseshoe Bay Mayor, Dr. Cynthia Clinesmith that there are now TWO confirmed COVID-19 cases in Llano County.

The second confirmed individual is a relative of the first confirmed case in Llano County (on 3/24/2020), is also travel-related on the same trip, and therefore, Llano County remains in Phase 3 (No Person-to-Person Spread) of our phased approach.

Both individuals self-quarantined immediately upon returning from their trip and remain in quarantine at this time.

As of this time, DSHS is reporting that 13,235 tests have been conducted in the state of Texas with at least 974 confirmed COVID-19 cases in Texas and 12 confirmed deaths related to COVID-19.
