**1700 BLK RANCH ROAD 2233
LLANO TEXAS**

Residents, Guests, Visitors, and Passersby:

DO NOT TOUCH OR HANDLE WILDLIFE!!!

On 3/12/26 a SKUNK was found, in the 1700 Block of RANCH ROAD 2233, in LLANO, TX. The SKUNK was tested by the Department of State Health Services and **was found to be POSITIVE FOR RABIES.**

Several wild animals in LLANO COUNTY areas *have* tested positive for rabies. **Please check your dogs/cats rabies vaccination certificates and have them updated as needed.** Please contact your Local Animal Control Officer or Veterinarian with questions regarding your rabies vaccinations.

All dogs and cats are required by **STATE LAW** to have a CURRENT rabies vaccination given by a veterinarian; this *does include* feral cats.

OWNER is defined as any person who **FEEDS**, shelters, harbors, has possession or control, or has the responsibility to control an animal.

If you see a suspicious animal, please do not approach it, contact the **Llano County Sheriff's Office** immediately.
