

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Texas Government Code §551.045, that an Emergency Meeting of the above named Commissioners' Court will be held on the **19<sup>th</sup> Day of March, 2020 at 3:00 P.M. in the Llano County Courthouse, Main Courtroom, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, 801 Ford Street, Llano, Texas**, at which time the court will deliberate or take action on the emergency or public necessity involving the COVID-19 (an epidemic) presidential, state and Llano emergency declarations and specifically the following subjects will be discussed, and appropriate action taken, to-wit:

The following subjects may or may not be discussed in the order shown.

**Agenda:**

1. **Update/Discussion:** on Llano County COVID-19 response including Llano emergency declaration and report on information received from Office of the Governor and TDEM. (RC and Commissioners)
2. **Discussion/Action:** relating to acquisition of Intellectual Property including laptops with cameras and software for the continued operation of Llano County government by specified office holders and individuals in the event government facilities are closed, partially staffed or the office holder, employee or employee's family is adversely affected by the COVID-19 virus emergency and as a result of the COVID-19 national, state (Governor Abbott) and/or Llano County judge emergency declarations. (RC)
3. **Discussion/Action:** relating to the creation and adoption of an emergency human resources policy ensuring that full time employees are paid in the event that county offices are closed, partially staffed or the employee or employee's family is adversely affected by the COVID-19 virus emergency. (RC)
4. **Discussion/Action:** relating to the creation and adoption of an emergency human resources policy ensuring that part-time employees are utilized and paid for temporary work assignment to the Llano County Office of Emergency Management during the COVID-19 emergency declaration period. (RC)
5. **Discussion/Action:** relating to the creation and adoption of an emergency human resources policy ensuring that Llano Sheriff's deputies and jailers are compensated in the event that Llano County government county offices are closed by either a presidential, state (Governor Abbott) or Llano County judge emergency declaration due to the COVID-19 virus emergency.
