RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF LLANO COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of the Llano County desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of Llano County to apply for funding under the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF LLANO COUNTY, TEXAS,

- 1. That a Texas Community Development Block Grant Program application for the Community Development Fund is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the County with the Texas Department of Agriculture, and to be placed in competition for funding under the Community Development Fund.
- 2. That the County of Llano commits to dedicating no less than 51% of grant funds for activities identified by the state planning region as Clearance and Demolition (004) as our First Priority, Cleanup of Contaminated Site (04A) as our Second Priority and Asbestos Removal (03R) as our Third Priority.
- 3. That all funds will be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local and programmatic requirements including but not limited to procurement, environmental review, labor standards, real property acquisition, and civil rights requirements.
- 4. That the Llano County is committing to provide \$112,500.00 in matching funds toward the application's activities, with the specific usage and funding source to be determined prior to any award of grant funding.
