Summary:

This is a non-exempt full-time position under the direction of the Jail Supervisor to assist in the operations of the Llano County Jail. Responsibilities and duties include but not limited to; overseeing, monitoring and documenting prisoner behavior and activities, enforcing jail rules and ensuring the safety of all those imprisoned, working within the confines of the jail and Texas Department of Jail Standards policies and procedures. Must be able to work as a team representing the Llano County Jail.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Follow and enforce all jail rules, internal policies and regulations
- Observe, monitor and document prisoner behavior, health and activities and quell or report any disturbances or potential, threatening issues to the Jail Supervisor, Sheriff and or Chief Deputy
- Prisoner transport
- Conduct personal, building and cell searches
- Classification of inmates
- Book prisoners
- Supervise trustees
- Ability to use physical force to break up altercations; restrain disorderly individuals
- Other duties as assigned

Qualification Requirements:

- Must be over (18) eighteen years old
- US citizen or permanent resident
- Strong work ethic and people skills
- A valid Texas drivers' license
- Pass a background check (with no felony convictions)
- Pass a drug and psychological test
